If your child/children or a family member have been advised to get a COVID-19 test and self-isolate as a result of showing signs of COVID the results must be provided to the school via email on admin@cherrylane.hillingdon.sch.uk before your child/children can return to school.

School Lunches – REMINDER

Regardless of a weekly text message being sent out to remind Parents to book school lunches, there has been an increasing number of parents not booking school lunches online for their child/children. All school meals MUST be booked via Parentpay before the end of the day every Wednesday for the following week. Please do not leave it until the last minute to book as we are not in a position to help you if you have any problems.

The period for booking meals is Thursday through to the next Wednesday for the following week, if you do not book within this time frame you will have to provide a packed lunch for your child for the following week. Please DO NOT forget to provide your child with a packed lunch if you have not booked online. If your child is entitled to Free School Meals or in Key stage 1 (Rec, Yr 1 & Yr 2) you still need to book school lunches online.
