Morning performance for **Morning parents** will be held in the upper hall on **Thursday 24th October 2024 at 11am - 11.20am.**


Afternoon performance for **Afternoon parents** will be held in the upper hall on **Wednesday 23rd October 2024 at 2.55pm - 3.15pm.**

We would love to see you all there to celebrate your children's learning this half term. We will be organising many more parent events over the coming year and can't wait to share them with you all.



Year 6 Parent event will be on Thursday 17th October from 2.45-3.15pm in classes. We will be looking forward to parents coming in and helping children design and sew their phone cases as part of DT topic this term.





In the first week after half term we will be discussing the NSPCC's Underwear Rule as part of our PSHE curriculum.

During these discussions we will aim to teach our pupils the following important safety skills without giving explicit information or telling scary stories. We will be teaching our pupils the NSPCC's Underwear Rule, using the 'PANTS' acrostic, which is like a green cross code for staying safe from sexual abuse.

PANTS stands for:





The lessons will introduce a range of ideas, all delivered in a way that's fully ageappropriate. These include:

- "appropriate" and "inappropriate" touching
- your child's right to say no to things that make them feel upset or uncomfortable
 - naming parts of the body
- who your child can turn to if they ever feel upset or worried.




