If your child is late to school, please make sure they come to the main reception, so they can be signed in.

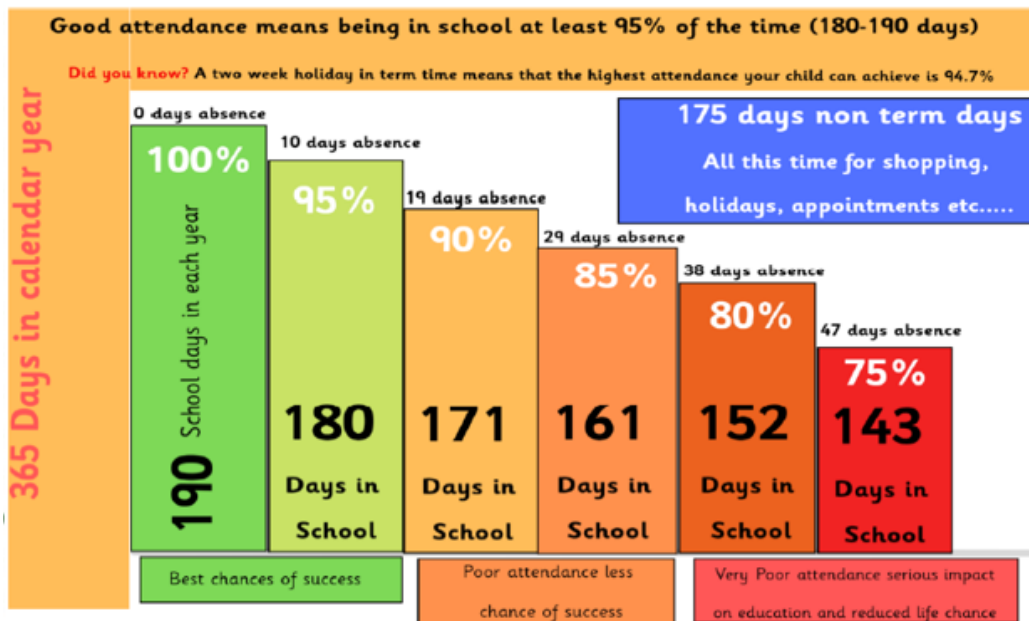
Learning starts at this time.
