### Science – Out of this world

- To learn how the planets in our Solar System are organised.
- To use mathematics to model the dimensions of our Solar System.
- To describe the movement of the Earth and Moon relative to the Sun in our Solar System.
- To identify scientific evidence that has been used to support a theory.
- To describe the movement of the Moon relative to the Earth.
- To use simple models to explain scientific ideas.

### Geography – A STUDY OF THE ALPINE REGION: Where should we go on holiday?

In this unit, the children will:

- use maps to focus on countries, cities and regions in Europe
- be taught to understand a region of another European country
- be taught to understand some of the physical and human processes that shape a region
- extend their knowledge and understanding beyond the local area to include Europe. This will include the location and characteristics of a range of the world's more significant human and physical features.
